INTRODUCTION

THE PREDECESSOR OF THE DELTA NEWS WAS THE ST. CLAIR FLATS BULLETIN. PUBLISHED BY THE ST. CLAIR FLATS ASSOCIATION PLEDGING. “AN ASSOCIATION DEVOTING ITS TIME AND ENERGY TO MAKE THE ST. CLAIR FLATS MORE LIVABLE; MORE HEALTHY AND ENJOYABLE; TO PROTECT WILD FOWL; TO ENFORCE ALL GAME LAWS; TO PROMOTE GOOD FELLOWSHIP AMONG ALL RESIDENTS; TO PROTECT PROPERTY OWNERS AND TO SECURE FOR THEM PERMANENT TITLES TO THEIR HOLDINGS”

ORIGINATED IN 1928, THE EIGHT-PAGE LEAFLET, ST. CLAIR FLATS BULLETIN, WAS PUBLISHED EVERY THREE MONTHS FOR FOUR (4) YEARS. IN VOLUME 1, NO. 4, AN ARTICLE REPORTED A MOTTO AS FOLLOWS: “*IN UNITY THERE IS STRENGTH*”.

FROM AN ARTICLE IN THE DELTA NEWS, “HARSEN’S ISLAND—ST. CLAIR FLATS---MERGER”, THE FOLLOWING APPEARS: “SINCE THE EARLY 1880’S THIS GREAT FISHING AND SHOOTING AREA HAS BEEN INHABITED BY MANY GREAT SPORTSMEN. SQUATTERS BUILT COTTAGES, BOATHOUSES, SHACKS, AND CLUBS IN THESE MARSHLANDS, BRINGING PEOPLE FROM THE MID- CENTRAL STATES.

“SLOW BUT STEADY PROGRESS WAS MADE TO ABOUT 1900 WHEN THE U.S. GOVERNMENT SURVEYED THIS PROPERTY AND LEASED IT, THROUGH THE STATE OF MICHIGAN, TO THE SQUATTERS FOR NINETY-NINE YEARS.

“LARGE SAILBOATS, STEAM YACHTS AND PASSENGER STEAMERS **WERE THE ONLY ACCESS TO THE DELTA IN THE ST. CLAIR RIVER...**THIS BEAUTIFUL AND PRIMITIVE COMMUNITY. TO KEEP ABREAST OF THE TIMES, IN 1918 THE ST. CLAIR FLATS ASSOCIATION WAS FORMED. THIS ASSOCIATION WAS LATER COMBINED IN 1945 WITH THE HARSEN’S ISLAND ASSOCIATION TO LOOK AFTER THE WELFARE OF THIS FAST GROWING RESORT”.

THE DELTA NEWS MAGAZINE FIRST APPEARED IN 1947 WITH A PUBLISHER’S STATEMENT ON THE MASTHEAD “REPORTING TO THE MEMBERS OF THE HARSEN’S ISLAND—ST. CLAIR FLATS ASSOCIATION ON ASSOCIATION ACTIVITIES, AND OTHER NEWS OF THE COMMUNITY”. IT WAS PUBLISHED AS A THIRTY-TWO (32) PAGE, EIGHT AND HALF INCH BY ELEVEN-INCH MAGAZINE.

THIS INDEX ALLOWS THE DELTA NEWS TO BE BETTER UTILIZED AS A RESEARCH TOOL AND REFERENCE GUIDE, TO HARSEN’S ISLAND PAST. THIS GUIDE IS IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER AND WILL ENABLE RESEARCHERS, HISTORIANS, STUDENTS AND MAGAZINE READERS TO FIND MATERIAL AND INFORMATION ON THE HISTORY OF HARSEN’S ISLAND AND THE ST. CLAIR FLATS.
